
Dear Baby,





Our Thoughts on Parenting



We enjoy creating a kid-friendly environment at home. This is our daily schedule, but there is always room for unexpected adventures!


Our Extended Family

Once we adopt, our moms will take turns staying with us and taking care of our 2 sons, so we can devote all of our attention to the new baby.



Dave's Family (left): Kim, Dave, Dave's mom and dad (Nana and Poppy) and his sister were all there to watch Dave earn his Ph.D.




Once we adopt, our family will be complete. We plan to celebrate by taking a Disney cruise!
